CARREER OVERVIEW

2019-2020 : Enterprise Architect and Solution / Project Architect at Athlon Car Lease International. As chairman responsible for the Enterprise Architecture Board. As a Solution / Project Architect within the Enterprise Architecture team (3 persons) I am responsible for the elaboration and supervision of project architectures in various areas such as: Credit Risk Assessment, International Remarketing Platform, Transport Logistics, Front-End Architecture for Marketing & Sales, Digital / Online Sales automation, Billing & Payment Solutions, Content Management, Document Management, Business Process Management (Camunda), Identity & Authorization Management (IAM), Robotic Process Automation, Target Hosting Architecture Landscape, Migration/Re-architecting Solutions for Cloud (AWS), introduction of Microservice architectures.

In this role I carry out various project activities in the field of feasibility studies, business analysis, process analysis, requirements engineering, procurement, architecture, design, Agile realization, testing, project management, training, coaching.
